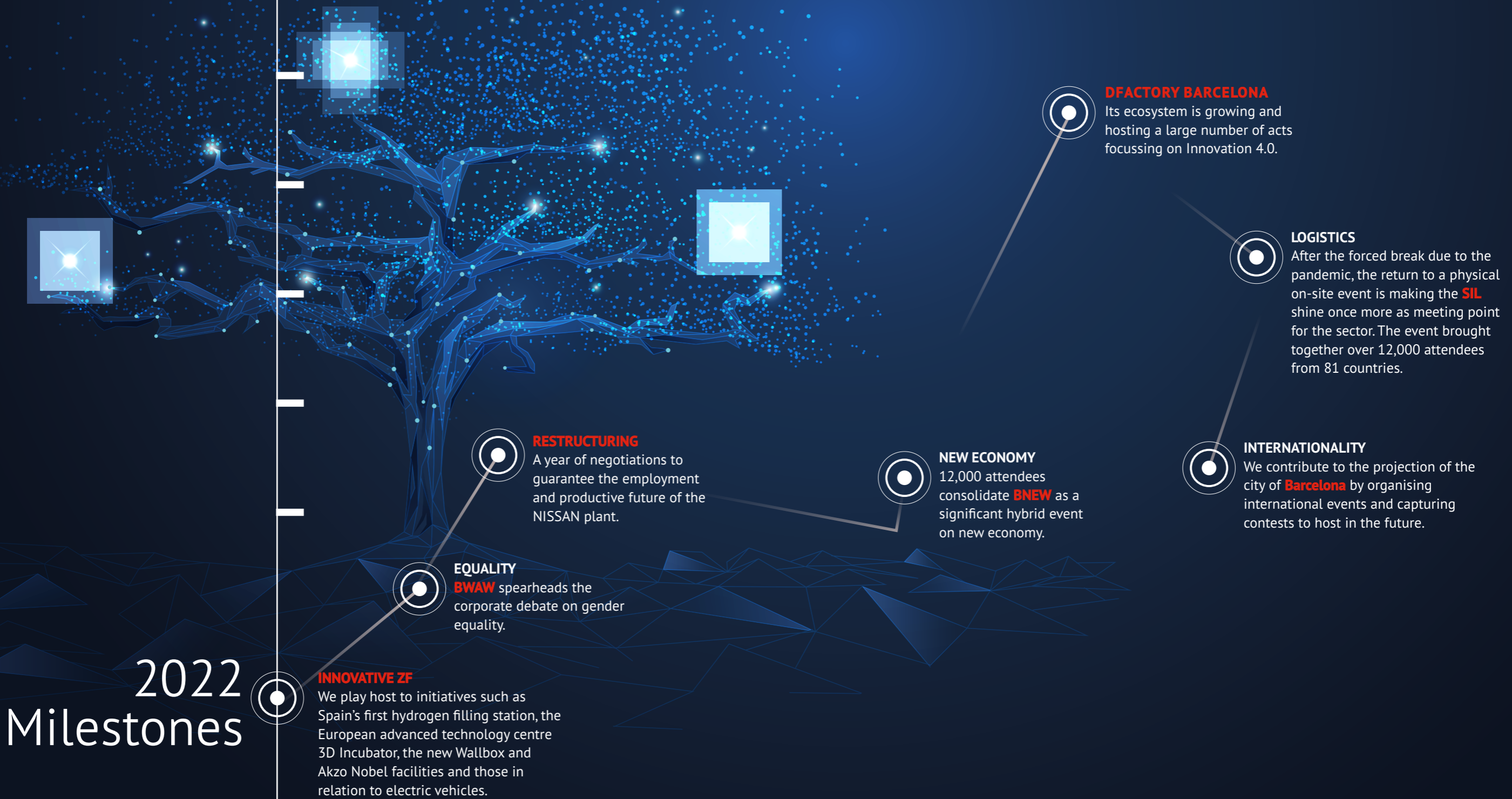

That success has also been achieved with the 3D Incubator, with its record-breaking total of 100 incubating companies.

The year 2022 ended achieving the goal of implementing the Strategic Plan for the Recovery and Economic Transformation (PERTE) of the electric vehicle, in addition to obtaining FEDER funds for the Logistics 4.0 advanced technology incubator. Furthermore, the key participation of the CZFB for the interests of the city in the negotiations for the industrial restructuring of the Nissan site.

The Consorci de la Zona Franca de Barcelona has consolidated itself as an important tool for transformation, combining transformational ambition towards Economy 4.0 with an environmental focus. Thanks to all those who are making this possible.

to position itself as an international reference for cutting-edge technology. There are already many corporate partners who support our vision. We're talking about shared success.

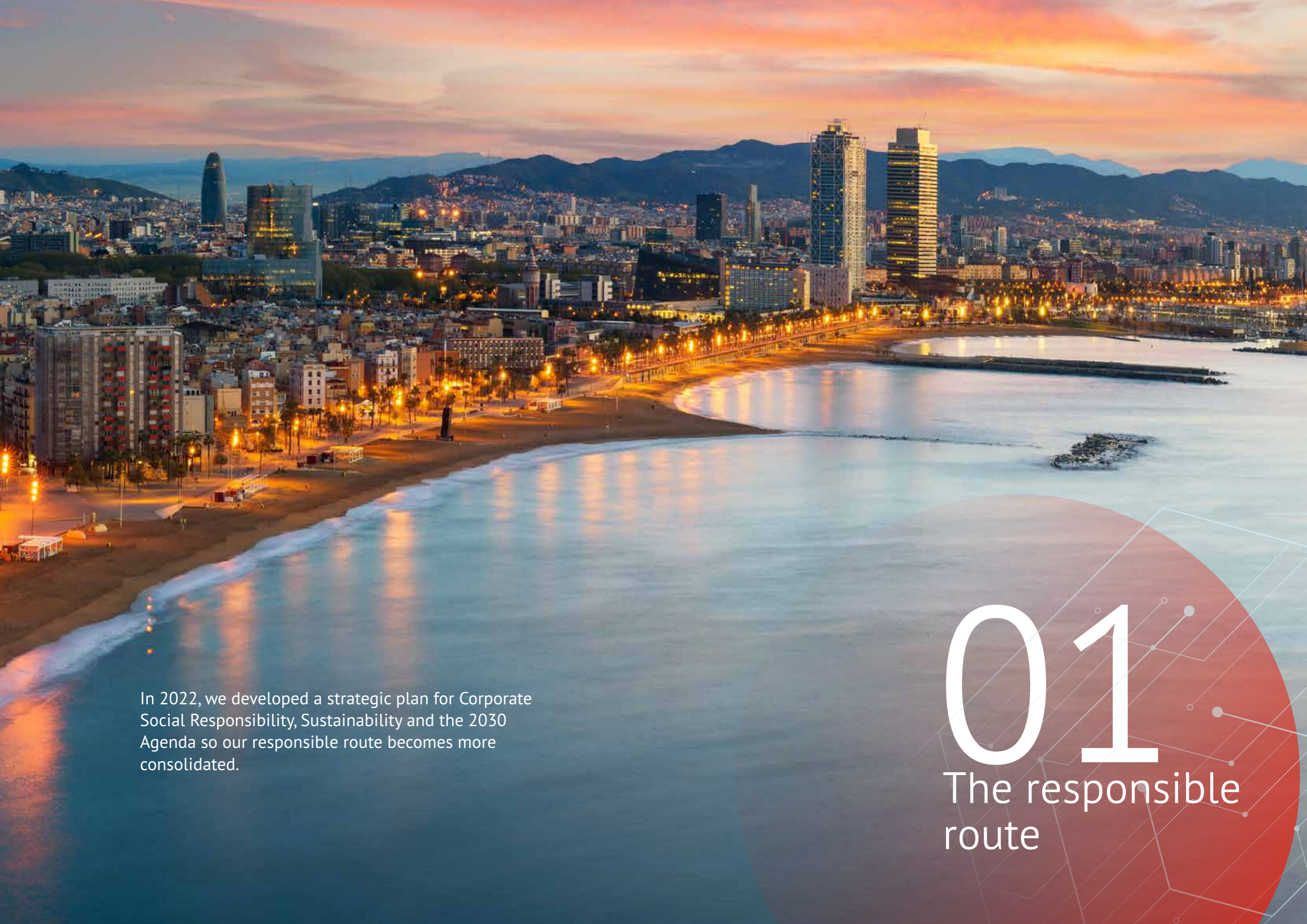

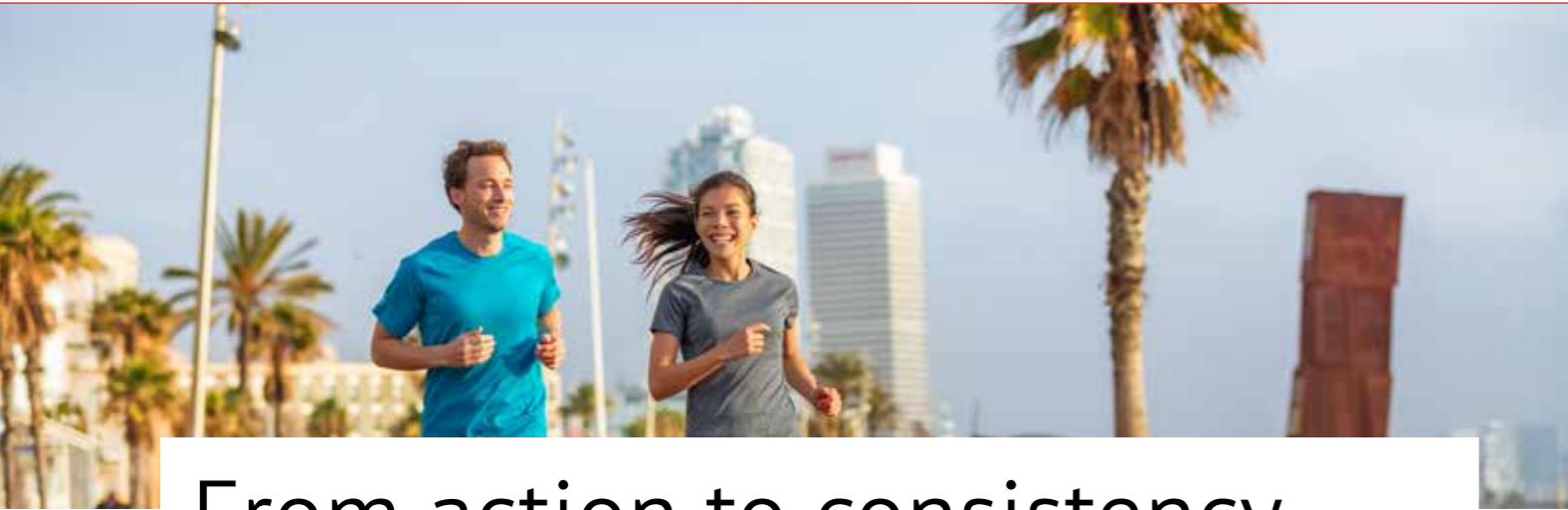
About us

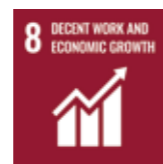

New Management Systems for CSR, Sustainability and the 2030 Agenda

Over the years, corporate practice has given rise to a large number of social commitment, environmental and economic initiatives that need to be structured, the Social Responsibility and Sustainability Policy of the CZFB being the definition of this goal. During 2022, a Strategic Plan for CSR, Sustainability and the 2030 Agenda was established, in line with our corporate idiosyncrasy, the interests of our stakeholders and the goals to comply within the 2030 Agenda.

Analysis of the internal and external context

Our new systems have a detailed context analysis record that is both internal and external. Besides, it is very useful to assess the risks and opportunities we will have to face in the near future and in the coming years. Our strategic lines and attention to the needs and expectations of the stakeholders are based on our knowledge of this context.

We assess aspects like our corporate culture, the condition of the infrastructures we manage, the economic situation and our capacity as a public body.

Approval of suppliers

In 2022, the Zona Franca proceeded to begin a Supplier Approval standardisation process to ensure equal opportunities between them and, at the same time, guarantee their commitments in terms of ethics and social responsibility.

The CZFB has optimised the procurement system in accordance with the Public Sector Procurement Act (PSPA) and has reinforced the "Conecta Centralización" centralised procurement platform.

Responsible purchases

At the same time, in 2022, the entity reduced its purchasing of paper by 14% with respect to the previous financial year, always purchasing recycled and ecological paper.

All purchases were made taking the following into account:

- ⦿ For products: we look for raw materials and production systems that are ecological and have certificates to prove it.
- ⦿ In services: concentrating services as much as possible to minimise travel.

New challenges beyond 2023

The Zona Franca ended 2022 with a forecast of the challenges it will take on over the coming years.



2nd Phase of DFactory Barcelona

The success of the DFactory concept and the large number of Companies 4.0 just a few months after its opening have led the Zona Franca to accelerate the design of a second phase of the complex. After the construction of its first building of 17,000m², the Consorci de la Zona Franca de Barcelona plans to develop more spaces for new innovative manufacturing technology and ecosystems on an adjoining plot of land. The entire complex may occupy a total of 100,000m², with an overall investment of 100 million euros planned.

The New Post Barcelona






Joint initiative of the CZFB, the City Council of Barcelona and Correos to transform the post office building in Via Laietana in Barcelona into a training hub for technological talent and a communications research centre, Correos Lab.

- ⊙ Restoration and modernisation of a unique, very emblematic building in the city of Barcelona in Via Laietana, located opposite the city's seafront.

The project, financed 50% from FEDER funds managed by the INCYDE Foundation, will select the world's 25 most attractive start-ups in the area of logistics with their own technology under development to enter the incubation programme.

Electric, connected vehicles

The industrial area of the Zona Franca de Barcelona is being called upon to become a laboratory for new mobility.

The evolution of the conventional car towards an electric, connected vehicle will bring productive innovations and changes in the connectivity and road management systems.

Amongst other initiatives, a connected vehicle testing area is to be developed in the spaces of the Zona Franca containing roads, in addition to an electromobility hub on the old NISSAN site. This industrial plan has obtained 65 million euros from the Strategic Project for Recovery and Economic Transformation to electric, connected vehicles (PERTE VEC).

Sabadell aeronautics innovation hub

The aeronautics industry is one of the most cutting-edge sectors in terms of the use of new technology and investment in R&D&i. The CZFB has teamed up with the City Council of Sabadell, Aena, the Polytechnic University of Catalonia and Barcelona Tech (UPC) in the promotion of an aeronautics innovation hub at the Sabadell airfield to boost innovation, training and entrepreneurship in this sector. The hub is a beneficial initiative for the business fabric and employment, as well as for university students and teaching and investigative personnel.

The search for a perfect balance between economic growth, caring for the environment, equality and social well-being defined the initiatives implemented by the Consorci de la Zona Franca de Barcelona during 2022.

Economic sustainability



An entity in continuous evolution

The CZFB has undergone a complete organisational transformation, going from having a structure aimed at the activity inherent to the real estate sector, to becoming one of the main agents promoting Economy 4.0 in Spain. Most of our activities and projects are aimed at innovation and the digital market, because in the next 20 years the vast majority of jobs will be digital.

Amongst the changes recorded during 2022, for example, the entity awarded the implementation of 5G-communications infrastructure for its own private use in the DFactory Barcelona building. In the corporate environment of the CZFB, the IT service has been modernised to better assist in the optimisation of processes, dynamisation of workflows and interconnection to ensure a remote working environment. In this respect, the comprehensive management system (ERP) which provides traceability for all internal processes has been consolidated and simplification and automation software (Prinex) has been implemented, in addition to the improvements made to the hours recording system, to transform the workplace and improve the usability, connectivity and access to meeting rooms and work spaces.

The entity has improved its administrative verification and accessibility measures by activating a document-consultation service using Secure Verification Codes (SVCs) on the Zona Franca's corporate website. At the same time, for yet another year, we have renewed our ISO 27001 certification in relation to the level of management in Information Security.

Internal reorganisation

Under the leadership of the Special Government Delegate Pere Navarro, CEO Blanca Sorigué, "who makes things happen in the Consorci de la Zona Franca de Barcelona", has managed to reinforce her transformational work on her own merits, thus earning herself a spot on the list of *Las 500 Mujeres más influyentes de España* (Spain's 500 most influential women) in 2022 for the second year running according to the ranking of the publication *Yo Dona* (Unidad Editorial). The changes brought about in the entity have transformed areas like people management, open leadership and the transversal vision of the strategic challenges. The departmental reorganisation implied the creation of a new Investment Department in 2022, run by Iñaki García.

An area in transformation

The complex restructuring of NISSAN

In May 2020, NISSAN announced the closure of its plants in Catalonia and subsequently, at the end of 2021, it ceased its industrial activity. From that moment, the Consorci de la Zona Franca de Barcelona, as a member of the Restructuring Commission for the NISSAN site, began to hold extensive, complex negotiations with the rest of the stakeholders –the Ministry of Industry, Government of Catalonia, NISSAN and the trade unions–, to safeguard the employment and future productivity linked to this production complex as much as possible.



The year 2022 was a key year in terms of finding an industrial alternative for NISSAN. In July, authorisation was granted to the electric motorbike manufacturing firm SILENCE to begin its industrial activity on 61,000m² of the NISSAN site and the hiring of previous employees of the car company retrained for electric mobility also began. In summer 2022, NISSAN received authorisation from its international parent company to continue carrying out the activity of its European Technical Centre (NTCE) on another 38,000m² of the industrial area of the Zona Franca,

thus maintaining the employment of 287 qualified engineers and workers.

For its part, the CZFB called a public tender in 2022 to award approximately 500,000m² of the plot vacated by the Japanese multinational for a period of 50 years, for which there was a single bidder, Australian logistics operator Goodman, together with the decarbonisation D-Hub created by QEV Technologies and Btech, which after some financial tension obtained 65 million euros in European aid for the automobile PERTE. The negotiation process between the parties continued even into 2023.

Wallbox inaugurates its new plant

The electric vehicle charging solutions manufacturer inaugurated its new factory in the Zona Franca Industrial Estate of Barcelona in April.

New AkzoNobel facility

Paint and coating manufacturer AkzoNobel inaugurated its Colour Development Lab in the Zona Franca for the development of colour for plastic parts in the automobile industry.

The new space is located in the company's headquarters in the Zona Franca and houses the production and R&D teams, allowing them to grow in terms of both development and quality control.

The Inspiring Hub

The CZFB created The Inspiring Hub, a digital inspirational space for advanced industrial activity where various companies located in the Zona Franca post videos showing their new developments or philosophies.

So far, firms such as Covestro, Picvisa and Odisey Music have used this communication platform which is open to companies with a story to tell.

ZF Nursery

The employees of all the companies that have settled in the industrial estate have the Somriures nursery available to them, fruit of the agreement with Marcabarna and Suara Cooperativa.

Environmental sustainability

Industry 4.0 cannot be understood without full awareness of the areas of sustainability, efficient use of resources and respect for the environment, meeting the needs of Society.

In this context, we have implemented various initiatives that demonstrate the awareness of our industrial fabric on this matter.



The ZF Hydrogen Filling Station is up and running

January 2022 saw the start of operations of Spain's first certified green hydrogen plant for public use, commissioned by TMB, built and operated by Iberdrola and with the indispensable support of the Consorci de la Zona Franca de Barcelona. The main purpose of the facility is to provide a hydrogen supply for TMB buses and other hydrogen-battery, electric vehicles for the transportation of passengers and goods in the area of Barcelona.

The commissioning of the hydrogen filling station, which has the installations to both supply green hydrogen and produce this, forms part of the CZFB's commitment to the implementation of the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goal's (SDGs) in the industrial sphere.

Thus we are promoting the use of sustainable energy through green hydrogen, which comes from the transformation of renewable energy and allows the assurance of zero greenhouse gas emissions from its production through to its complete consumption by vehicles.



Energy and mobility, the spearhead of sustainability

Mobility in the 21st Century is closely related to sustainability and adequate management of energy sources. The CZFB is firmly committed to this new reality and supports initiatives like the production and supply of hydrogen and the expansion of electric vehicle charging points in its facilities.

Alliance for decarbonisation

The Zona Franca maintains its commitment to decarbonisation, the new sustainable mobility and the fight against climate change. In this respect, we signed an agreement with AMB for the decarbonisation of the metropolitan territory of Barcelona, an agreement in which also participates the State, the Government of Catalonia, various city councils and other entities like AENA and the Port of Barcelona.

The purpose of the alliance is to carry out proposals in relation to ecology, mobility, transport and social and economic development from a sustainable and efficient perspective.



Conference on regenerated water

The CZFB and the Catalan Water Agency organised a conference to present the project –still in the design phase– for the use of regenerated water in industry to the industries of the Zona Franca. Contact has been made with the companies to find out their potential volume of consumption of regenerated water and thus know the size of infrastructure needed to supply them, which would mitigate the consequences of a drought situation.

Commitment to photovoltaic energy

Continuing with the actions of previous years, we have maintained our commitment to the use of photovoltaic energy and work groups have been created with the companies of the industrial estate to promote the use of renewable energy and take advantage of the roofs of the warehouses to install photovoltaic panels. Several dozen companies have already joined this energy cooperation project.



Think green

Under this concept, the Zona Franca is promoting the naturalisation of the area by improving the vegetation, rest areas and landscaped spaces which, together with the improved roads and signage, aims to create a more natural, pleasant, human and collaborative space.



Industry and Energy forum

February saw the 1st Industry and Energy Conference, organised by the Consorci de la Zona Franca de Barcelona and the Industry and Energy Forum (FIE). During the session, participants talked about the energy needs of industry and the contribution of the different technologies to the ecological transformation process.

The Conference turned the offices of the CZFB into a space for dialogue open to multiple actors involved in energy management for industry, from energy producers to the consumer industries and including administration, technology manufacturers and the academic institutions.



Circular economy actions

We have maintained our commitment to circular economy actions that help companies of the industrial sphere to reduce or recycle their waste.

The collaboration between companies and the more efficient use of these resources allows the companies of the Zona Franca to move towards "Zero Waste" management, reduce costs, contribute to sustainable development and establish a circular economy more in line with the new Economy 4.0.



Sustainable mobility

We remain committed to mobility with a low environmental impact through measures such as the promotion of improvements to public transport, the installation of electric charging points in DFactory Barcelona, support for different means of shared transport and the promotion of the use of bicycles in a bicycle lane network that continues to grow.

EMAS certification



Since 2009, we have had EMAS certification. The CZFB was the first industrial estate to obtain this recognition for the management of its communal areas.

The impact the Consorci de la Zona Franca has on the industrial, logistics and innovative ecosystem of Barcelona is undeniable and essential in its commitment to the projection of great Barcelona.

And its leadership doesn't stop at ground-breaking innovation initiatives. The Consorci de la Zona Franca de Barcelona also contributes to the dynamisation of the economy through conferences linked to the world of economy such as the SIL Barcelona, the important logistics fair that will be celebrating its 25th year in 2023, and BNEW, an innovative event begun in the middle of the COVID pandemic.

The knowledge the Consorci de la Zona Franca has of the business fabric, in addition to the alliances it forms with public and private entities, are trump cards it plays in the city's favour in sectors such as industry, the new Economy 4.0 and logistics.

This social prestige and its dedication to the Barcelona brand have contributed to the CZFB being recognised as one of Spain's most influential brands*, attracting the support of international congresses and events that trust in its organisational know-how in the world of economics.

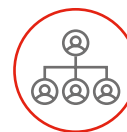
